

## <u>Turolight® LED Limited Warranty</u> For Professional, Industrial/Commercial Customers and Applications Only

Turolight Inc.("Turolight") warrants that its LED line of products listed below (the "Products") will be free from defects in material and workmanship, subject to the terms and conditions herein.

If a Product fails to conform with this limited warranty for the specified period below, Turolight<sup>®</sup> will, at its sole option and discretion, replace the Product at no charge or grant purchaser a credit for a future Product purchase. Unit credit is calculated as following manner [(Invoiced Purchase Price (\$) x Unexpired Warranty Period (operating hours)]. Please see the warranty period listed in the table below:

2. LED tubes are operated with Normal BF ballasts on our compatible list. Warranty will become 3 years if operating with High BF ballasts on our compatible list.

For avoidance of doubt, "to replace the Product" does not include any removal or reinstallation costs or expenses, including without limitation labor costs or expenses, shipping costs to return non-conforming Products or any damages that may occur during the return of Product to Turolight.

This limited warranty only applies to Products registered with Turolight® as part of an installation project within thirty (30) days from date of installation. - 3. Turolight<sup>®</sup> representative will have access to the failed Products and the fixtures used to operate them. If the fixture or other parts become suspect, the representative shall have the right to invite other manufacturers' representatives to evaluate the lighting system components.
- 4. The Product has been purchased directly from an authorized Turolight® distributor/dealer.
- 5. This warranty is limited to lamps purchased for use in regions that are within the jurisdiction of Canada.
- 6. Purchase receipt for the Product is available for inspection by Turolight®.

The warranty and remedy set forth herein do not apply to Products, parts, advice, assistance or service, which Turolight<sup>®</sup> furnishes to purchaser as a business courtesy. The warranty is not applicable to any Product that is used in violation of any applicable standard, code or instructions for use, including those contained in the Standards for Safety of Canadian Underwriters Laboratory, Inc. (cUL), Standards for the Canadian Standards Association (CSA).
